

**Driving Directions to
Napa Valley Marriott Hotel & Spa**

FROM SAN JOSE/SAN FRANCISCO: Take US-101 N over the Bay Bridge. Take I-80 E to exit #33 onto CA-37 W toward Napa. Take exit #19 and turn right on CA-29 N. Take exit #19 and turn left on Redwood Road. Turn right on Solano Avenue.

FROM MARIN COUNTY, 19TH AVENUE, DALY CITY: Take the Golden Gate Bridge and US-101 N to exit #460A onto CA-37 E toward Napa/Vallejo. Bear left on CA-121 (Infineon Raceway). Follow CA-121 approximately 16 miles and turn left at its junction with CA-29. Continue on CA-29 N and take exit #19, turning left on Redwood Road. Turn right on Solano Avenue.

FROM SACRAMENTO: Take I-80 W to the Napa/Sonoma exit onto Jameson Canyon Road, CA-12 W. Turn right on CA-29 N. Take exit #19 and turn left on Redwood Road. Turn right on Solano Avenue.
