- Turn left at Highway 28, North Lake Boulevard - 0.3 miles
- The North Tahoe Event Center is on the right

#### From Reno

- Take Interstate 80 west
- Take exit 188 for State Route 267. Turn left onto State Route 267 - 12 miles
- Turn left at Highway 28, North Lake Boulevard - 0.3 miles
- The North Tahoe Event Center is on the right

#### From South Lake Tahoe

- Take US Highway 50 (Lake Tahoe Boulevard) east, follow US 50 north around the east shore of the lake - 15 miles
- Turn left at State Route 28, follow it to Kings Beach - 17.6 miles
- The North Tahoe Event Center is on the left
